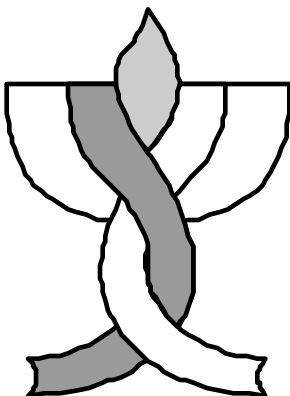




MAR CHESHVAN

Jewish calendar months are either 29 or 30 days in length. Most months follow a fixed schedule, so that Nisan is 30 days, Iyar—29 days, Sivan—30 days, and so on; however, both Mar Cheshvan and Kislev are variable months. When Mar Cheshvan is 29 days (following an always 30 day Tishri), Kislev can be either 29 or 30 days. This year Mar Cheshvan has 29 days and Kislev has 30 days. This follows the standard cycle and therefore this year is called “K’sidran” — “according to the ordinary cycle.”

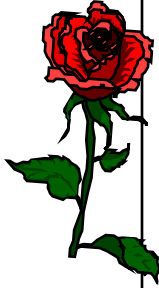
