# ELUL

In Chodesh Elul, we begin the process of introspection. This process culminates on Yom Kippur. Whereas our Sephardic brethren recite Selichot throughout the entire month, our practice is to blow the Shofar at Shacharit and recite Psalm 27 at both Shacharit and Mincha for the month of Elul. We begin our Selichot recitation very early on the Sunday morning before Rosh Hashana.

The Hebrew letters for Elul: "Aleph, Lamed, Vov, Lamed," are used by the Midrash to represent the famous verse in Shir Hashirim: "Ani L'Dodi V'Dodi Li," — "I am my beloved and my beloved is mine." The "beloved" represents G-d; thus, throughout Elul our introspection and Tshuva are designed to recover our love and reconciliation with G-d.

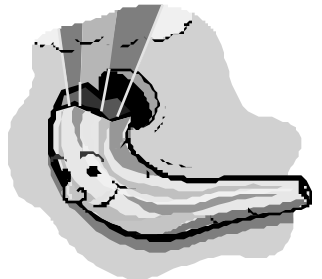

## Have you seen the new Aron at Shul?

Over the past year, the Aron Kodesh in the Main Sanctuary has undergone a notable renovation. We now have an Aron that we can be proud of; one that displays and supports the Sifrei Torah with the proper Kavod.

The new Aron has:

- ◆ Stadium seating for 9 Sifrei Torah.
- ◆ Mahogany braces and tracks to hold the Sifrei Torah.
- ◆ Special lighting to accent the silver.
- ◆ The crowns now remain on the Sifrei Torah at all times.
- ◆ Tempered glass doors with an ironwork Eitz Chaim.
- ◆ The Eitz Chaim has 7 branches and 63 leaves (7x9).
- ◆ Last but not least: a lock has been installed.

The construction was done by McGinty Construction, a family of craftsman, with design help from Ruth Weider and David Seltzer. The ironwork was done by artist Gary Wershing, who lives in southern Ohio.

We would like to thank Joe & Marla Shafran, Morry & Judy Weiss, Gary & Cari Gross, and Philip Baskin for funding this project.



You will also notice that we have new Torah covers that use the color scheme from the beautiful Parochet that was donated by Goldie Pearl and the late Joseph Pearl and family. These covers also include words that incorporate "Eitz Chaim Hee."

The **Perl Hall** also has a new Parochet and Bima cover, which has been donated by the regulars from our daily Minyan. They invite and encourage everyone to join the weekday Minyan and see the new Parochet.
