FROM OUR RABBI...



MAR HESHVAN

This year 5768 is a leap year in the Jewish calendar. This means that an extra month will be added to the calendar - Adar HaSheni. It is also a Sh'mitta year or a Sabattical year. In Israel, this means that the agricultural land is supposed to lie fallow. Many farms in Israel observe this total stricture. However, with the beginnings of modern Jewish settlement in Eretz Yisrael in the 1880's the early settlements faced a dilemma on the Sh'mitta year. Full observance would almost certainly have jettisoned the entire national enterprise in the land. Representatives of the Jerusalem rabbinate visited the settlements forewarning the farmers of the requirement of leaving the land fallow. The farmers appealed to Gedolei HaTorah in Czarist Russia for advice. Led by such luminaries as Rav Sh'muel Mohilever and Rav Yitshak Elhanan Spector, a dispensation to sell the land to a non-Jew was devised to allow agricultural work to continue. Interestingly, the settlement of Petah Tikvah observed the Sh'mitta strictures and survived the year on Tsedaka. The Heter Mekhira was soon institutionalized for the bulk of the settlements and was later endorsed by Rav Kook after the creation of the Chief Rabbinate after World War I.
